The speaker will provide the learner with a succinct summary of the articles on CDC guidelines on opioid use, vertebroplasty, efficacy of epidural steroid vs saline, interlaminar, transforaminal, and caudal epidural steroid, Ziconotide, and placebo effect of spinal cord stimulation. Opportunities for evidence-based pain management will be suggested.
