Dr. Hyungtae Kim is a highly accomplished anesthesiologist and pain medicine specialist with over two decades of experience in clinical practice, teaching, and research. Over the years, he has held several academic and clinical roles, including Clinical Associate Professor and Assistant Professor, before being promoted to his current role in 2024.

Dr. Kim is an active member of multiple medical societies, including the Korean Society of Anesthesiologists, Korean Pain Society, and the American Society of Regional Anesthesia.
